In the table, there are lots of different homework activities to choose from. You can choose to do an activity whenever you like. <p><b>Maths Game Creation:</b> Design a simple board game that helps players practice addition or subtraction.</p> 	<p><b>Volcano Fact File:</b> Research a famous volcano (like Mount Vesuvius, Mount Fuji, or Mauna Loa) and create a fact file with interesting information about it.</p> 	<p><b>BFG's Meal Time Maths:</b> If the BFG eats snozzcubers that are 20 times larger than Sophie's, draw or write out what the size difference would look like with objects you know, like apples or sandwiches.</p> 
<p><b>Volcano Art:</b> Using coloured paper or other materials, make a volcano scene. Add details like lava, ash clouds, and nearby landscape features like trees or rocks.</p> 	<p><b>Giant's Dictionary:</b> The BFG uses unique words like "snozzcumber" and "whizzpopper." Make a mini-dictionary of five to ten of the BFG's funny words. Write a definition for each one, and maybe add an illustration!</p> 	<p><b>Volcano Vocabulary Crossword:</b> Make a simple crossword puzzle or word search with words like "eruption," "lava," "magma," "crater," and "ash."</p>
